Dear Friends,

On behalf of the Executive Council and Scientific Organizing Committee of the International Society for the Study of Vulvovaginal Disease (ISSVD), it is our great pleasure to invite you to join us for the 25th Biennial Conference on Diseases of the Vulva and Vagina. This course will be aired on September 11 & 12, 2020 as an online virtual experience. There is a basic course with a hands-on workshop on biopsy technique and a hands-on physical therapy workshop that will be offered to those interested, on September 10th. All attendees will continue to have access to course materials and recordings for a minimum of six months after the initial airing.

The International Society of Vulvovaginal Disease (ISSVD) is the only international organization with specific aims to educate all medical professionals providing care for children, adolescents and adults with vulvovaginal disease. The ISSVD meets every other year around the world and provides a platform for networking and presenting research updates, uniform terminologies and new ideas and technologies.

In between World Congresses, our experts offer this biennial conference as a unique educational opportunity that allows providers to learn from the world's leading experts in a collaborative and supportive environment.

The two-day course encompasses essential lectures on vulvovaginal diseases, ample opportunity for discussion and case presentations. This course is ideal for those providing care for children, adolescents and adults with vulvovaginal disease and for clinicians who treat patients with persistent or recurrent vulvar symptoms not explained by simple yeast infections or bacterial vaginosis. It will also benefit practitioners who treat itching, dyspareunia, and pain, as well as vaginal discharge, and chronic rashes. The conditions include recurrent candidiasis, lichen simplex chronicus, lichen planus, lichen sclerosus, vulvodynia, ulcers, and desquamative inflammatory vaginitis.

We expect 350 registrants with a substantial proportion being key decision makers and budget holders for their health institutions. This course has sold out the past two times it was offered.

The interdisciplinary team working in the vulvovaginal disease field, including gynecologists, dermatologists, pathologists, oncologists and physical therapists, is the main ingredient to a successful meeting and better patient management and overall care.

To continue with this education, research and innovation in diagnostics and clinical treatments, it is becoming increasingly difficult to treat patients with vulvovaginal diseases without the STRONG support of the pharmaceutical and medical supply industries.

- Promote international communication among gynecologists, pathologists, dermatologists, and related disciplines, and to encourage communication and education between our specialties.
